***Sweet Mother's Day Breakfast Treat!***

**Ingredients**

- 2 pints fresh strawberries
- 1/2 cup firmly packed brown sugar
- 1 cup milk
- 1 cup all purpose flour
- 1/8 teaspoon salt
- 3 large eggs
- 2 tbl spoons butter
- 1 cup whipping cream
- 2 tablespoons powdered sugar



**Directions**

Combine Strawberries and sugar and set aside. Add milk to the flour and salt, beat until smooth. Add eggs and beat well while stirring in the melted butter. Refrigerate one hour. Coat a skillet with vegetable oil and spread the batter into a thin film. Cook one minute. Shake loose and flip to cook the other side for 30 seconds. Whip cream until stiff peaks form. Spoon 1/4 cup strawberry mixture into crepe and top with whip cream. Enjoy!
